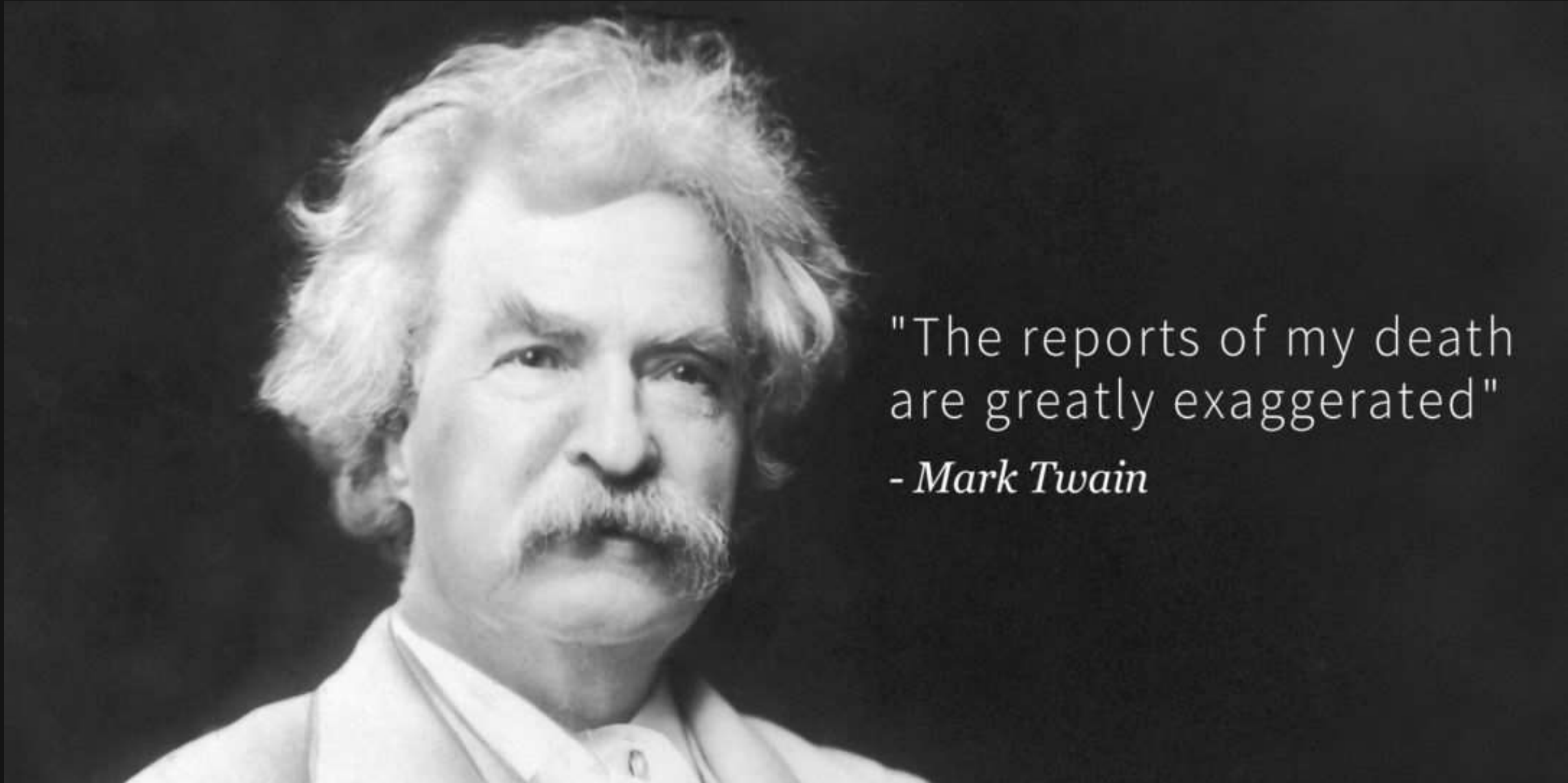

- IBM has acquired Red Hat for \$190.00 per share in cash, approximately \$34 billion. Acquisition completed on July 9, 2019
- Red Hat will operate as a distinct unit within IBM and will be reported as part of IBM's Cloud and Cognitive Software business.
- Red Hat's mission and unwavering commitment to open source remain unchanged and Red Hat leadership will continue to make decisions on operating practices and strategy, development model, product portfolio, services, and go-to-market strategy
- Synergy: IBM and Red Hat work cultures are seen as working together, not merging
- Red Hat continues to work with ALL partners, including IBM
- Red Hat continues to deliver the same set of values to our customers

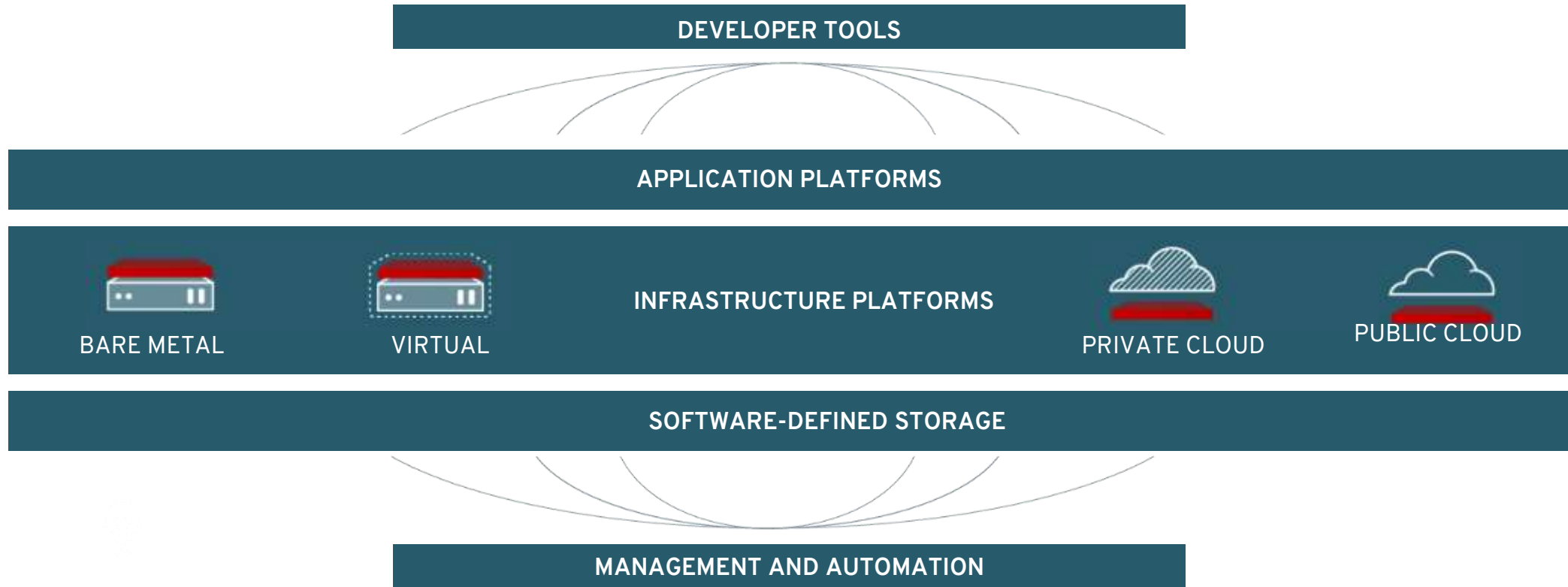
